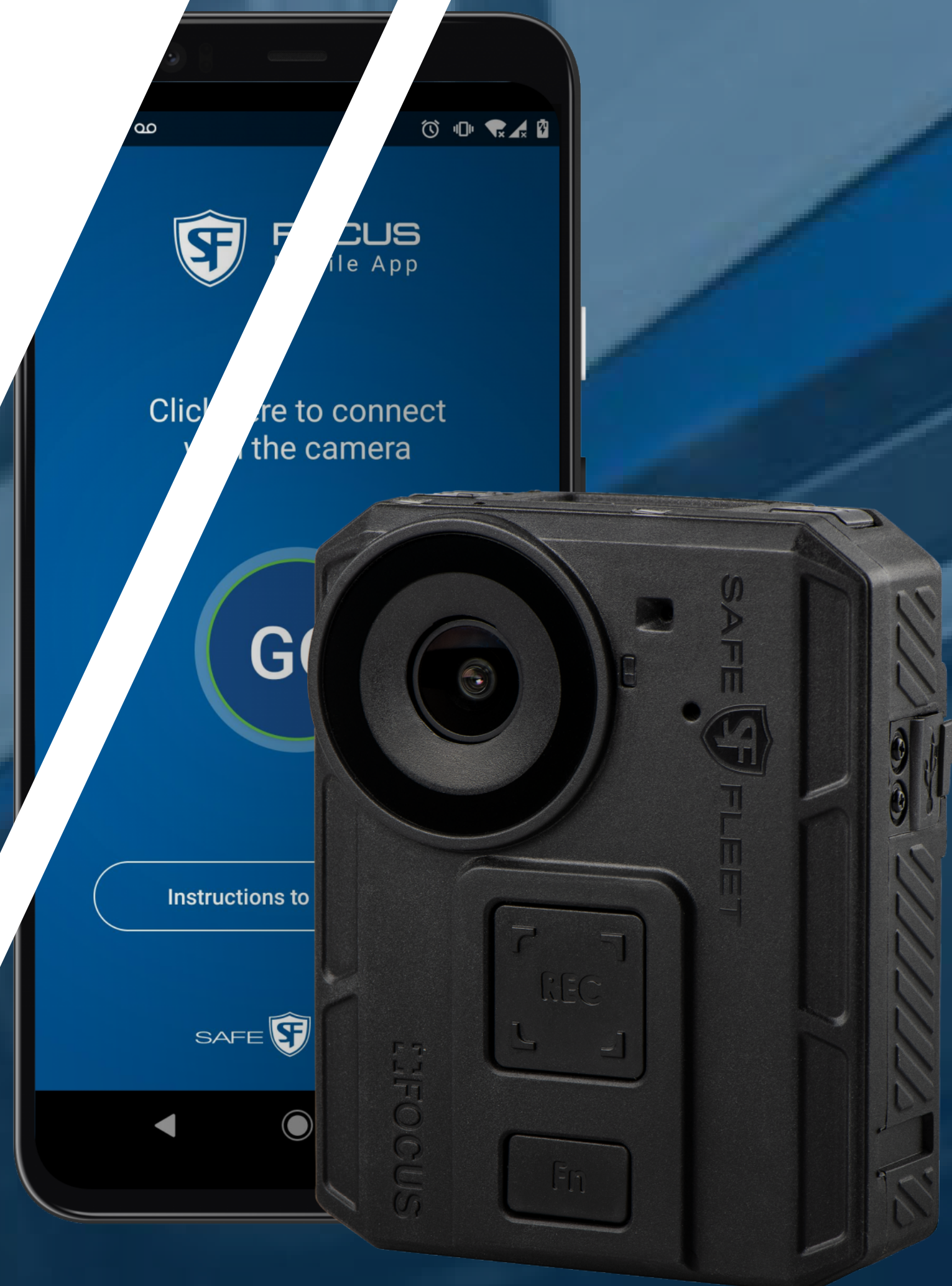

When you start the app for the first time, it will likely prompt whether you approve the app to access Bluetooth and/or WiFi. Tap **OK** to allow Bluetooth access.

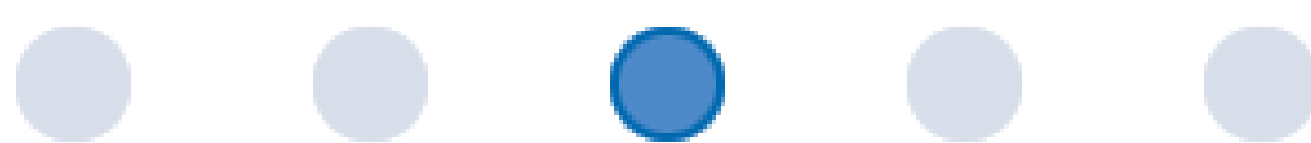

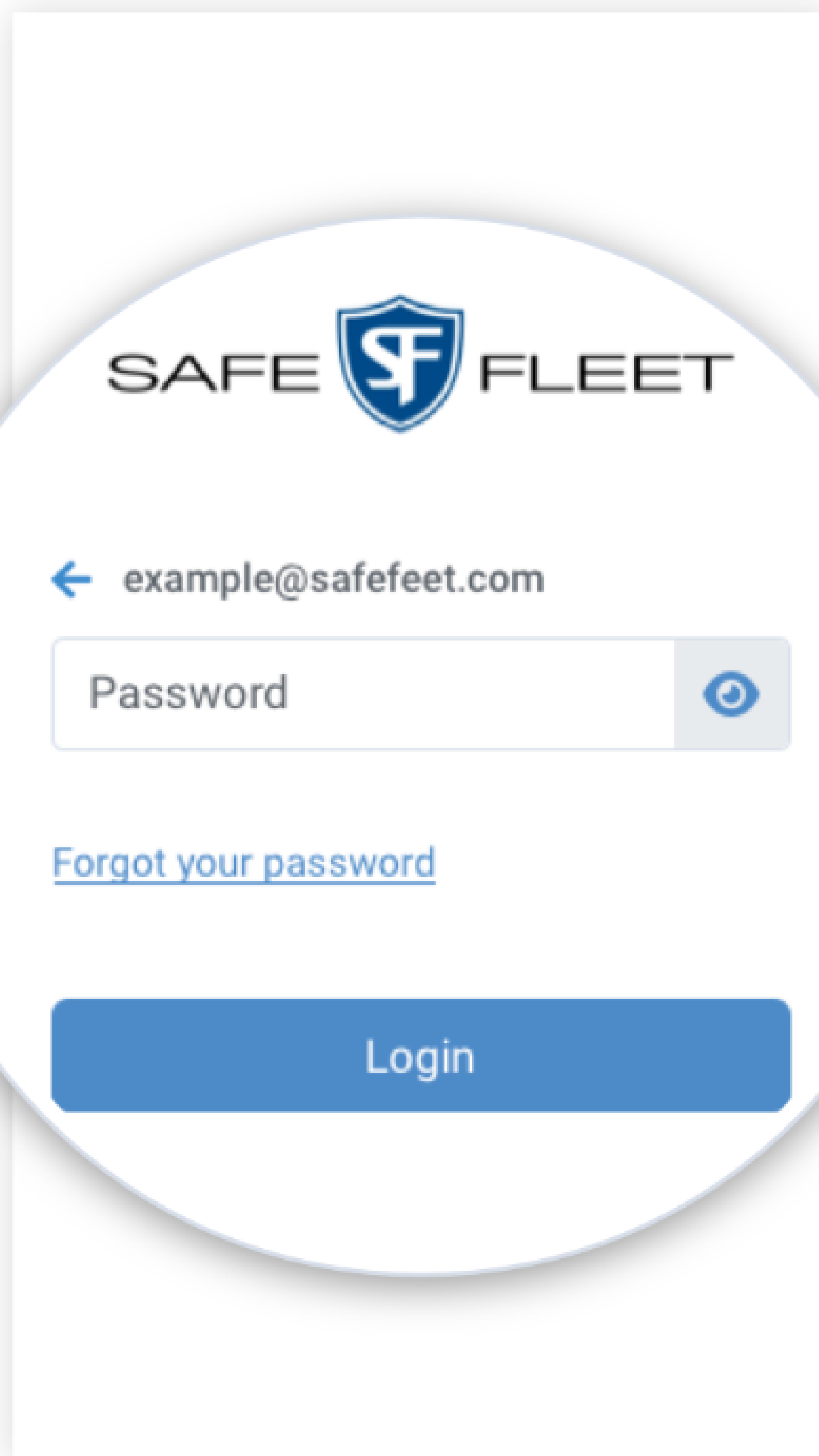

## **Connecting to WiFi**

After successful login, FMA will try to connect to the device WiFi. You must select **Join** or **Connect** in order to allow the mobile device to connect to the FOCUS X2. Once you tap **Join**, you will be redirected to the Home page.

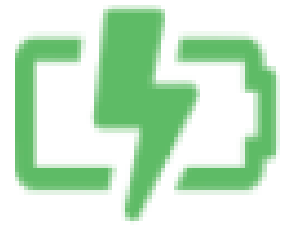

## Live View ON

If **Live view** is enabled, you'll see your Body Camera's feed here. You can view it in full screen mode by tapping the  icon in the bottom-right corner of the video display area.

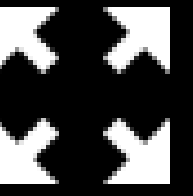

## Live View OFF

**Live View** is enabled by default. If you disable it, the video display area will be grayed out, but snapshots and videos will be recorded as usual. If you take a snapshot or start a video recording when Live View is off, the Live View will be enabled automatically.

## Body Camera Details

The **Body Camera Status** area displays the battery status of your Body Camera, as well as the memory usage details.

Tapping the drop-down arrow at the top of the **Body Camera Status** area will display the **Body Camera Settings**, which will be explained in the next page.

The  icon in the top-right corner opens a number of menu options. The  icon opens a list of event notifications.

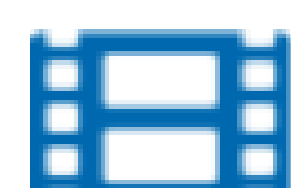
## Body Camera Settings

Tapping the arrow at the top of the **Body Camera Status** area will show/hide the **Body Camera Settings**. The drop-down arrow is at the top of some other pages as well.

The 3 icons in the **Body Camera Settings** area are Covert Mode, Bluetooth, and GPS (from left to right), which will be displayed in grey when inactive. You cannot click on the icons to effect changes. To change these, go to the menu  and choose **Body Camera Settings**.

# Snapshots

You can take snapshots of what you see in the Body Camera feed at any time, even when a recording is in progress. Snapshots function as photo evidence in addition to the recorded videos.

Snapshots are captured when you tap the highlighted button. Once captured, snapshots are saved to the Body Camera's memory, and displayed in the **View Snapshots** list.

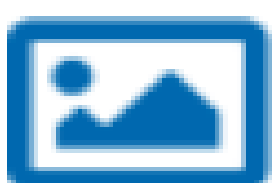

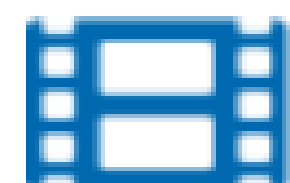

# Videos

You can start recording from your Body Camera using the FMA whenever you feel the need for video evidence. The video display area displays the Body Camera's feed. Tap the highlighted button to start recording, and tap this button again to stop recording. Once recorded, videos are saved to your Body Camera's memory, and displayed in the **View Videos** list.

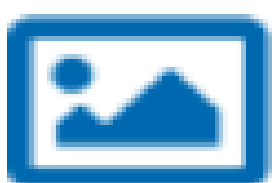

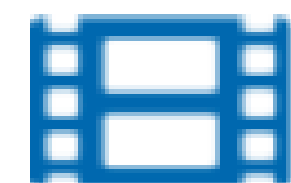

## View Snapshots List

Snapshots are saved as JPG files to your Body Camera's memory, and displayed in the **View Snapshots** list. You can access this list from here. Snapshots can also be accessed by tapping the  icon in the top-right corner.

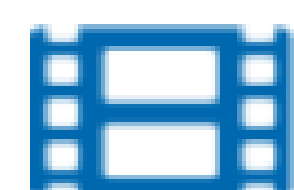
When the snapshots from your Body Camera are uploaded to the back office, your Body Camera's memory is cleared, and the list becomes empty.

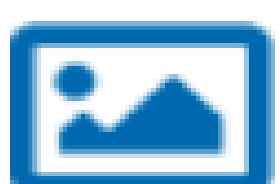
## View Videos List

Videos you record are saved to your Body Camera's memory as MP4 files, and displayed in the **View Videos** list. You can access the **View Videos** list by tapping here. Videos can also be accessed by tapping the  icon.

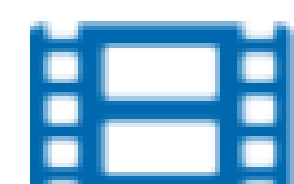
When the videos are uploaded from the Body Camera to the back office, your Body Camera's memory is cleared. The **View Videos** list also appears empty.

## Take Snapshot

Observe the Body Camera feed in the video display area. To take a snapshot, tap this button. You should hear a click sound, indicating that the snapshot has been taken.

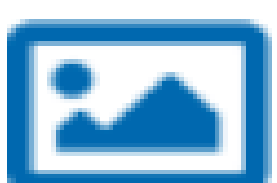
Tap **View Snapshots** to access the snapshots list. The snapshots you captured will appear at the top.



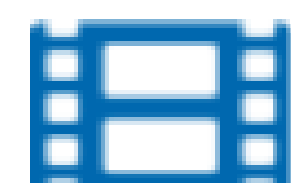

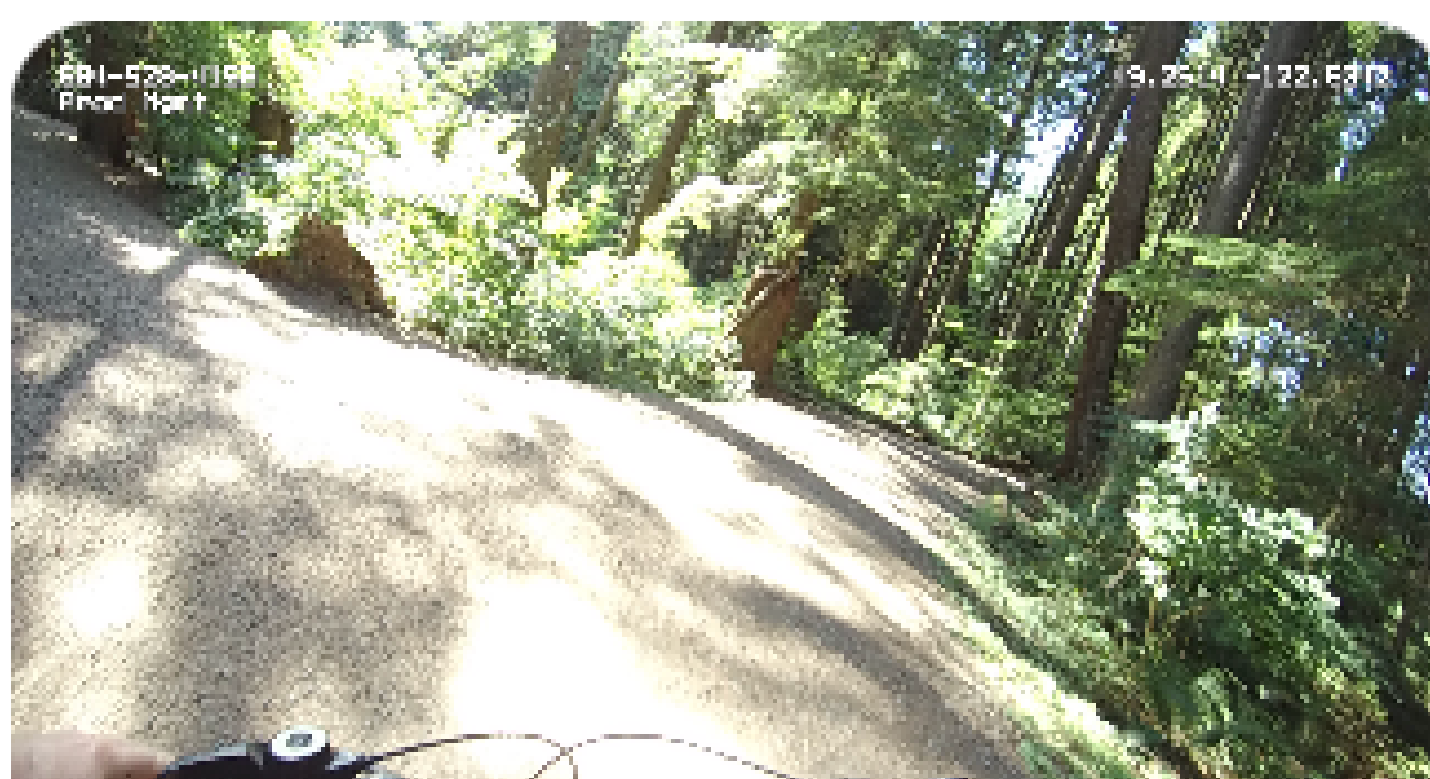

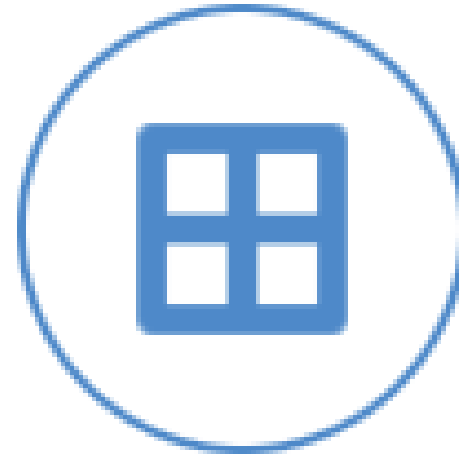

## View Snapshots List

The list format is available by tapping the List icon in the top-right corner.

You'll see the name of the snapshot, the date and time it was taken.

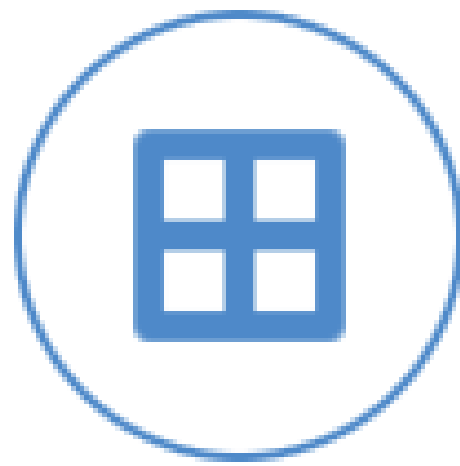
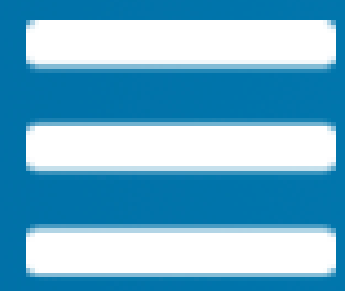
For non-Nexus users, you will see the **Associate with an officer** button at the bottom. Tap the button to associate this snapshot with an officer (e.g. Partner).

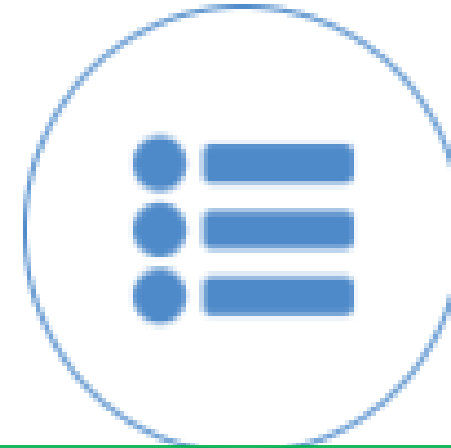

## Filter the Snapshot List

Set a start date and an end date, and then tap **Apply**. You need not use both the fields to filter the list. For example, you can filter the list by using only **End date**.

# Enable Snapshot Selection

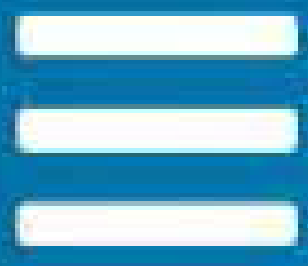
For non-Nexus users, you can use the **Select** button to enable snapshots selection for bulk association with a partner officer. When you tap **Select** in the top-left corner, check boxes will appear next to snapshots. Here, the snapshots are displayed in grid view.

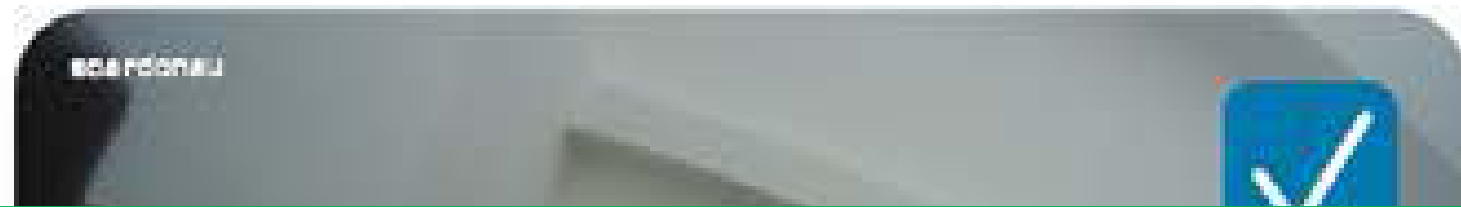

## Provide Officer ID

## Record Video

Observe the Body Camera feed, and when appropriate, tap this button. The icon changes to: . This indicates the Body Camera is recording.

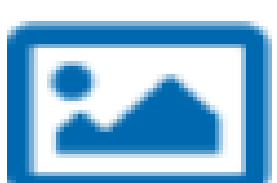
At the same time, the Body Camera will vibrate, blink the front LED, or do both, depending on your settings.



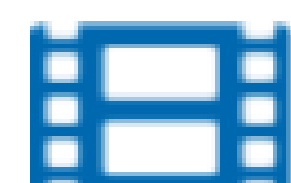

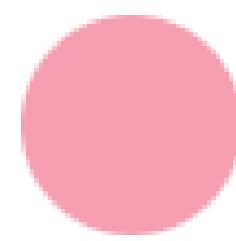

## Stop Recording

When a video is recording, the **video recording** icon appears next to the **Live view** slider.

Recording can be stopped by tapping here. The icon will then change to , indicating that the recording has stopped.

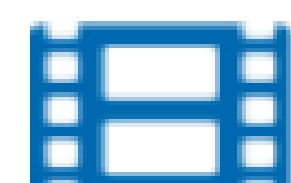

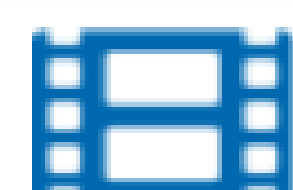

## Videos List

The videos stored in the Body Camera's memory appear here. You can tap the Sort icon next to the column name to sort the columns. (For non-Nexus users, the **Category** column is shown as **Event**.)

You can also tap any video to edit its properties.

## Video Properties

The video that you tapped starts playing. Now, you can edit its properties. Observe that **Name**, **Duration**, and **Start Time** cannot be edited.

Scroll up and down to see more properties. Notice that **Event/Category** is available as drop-down list.

## Select an Event/Category

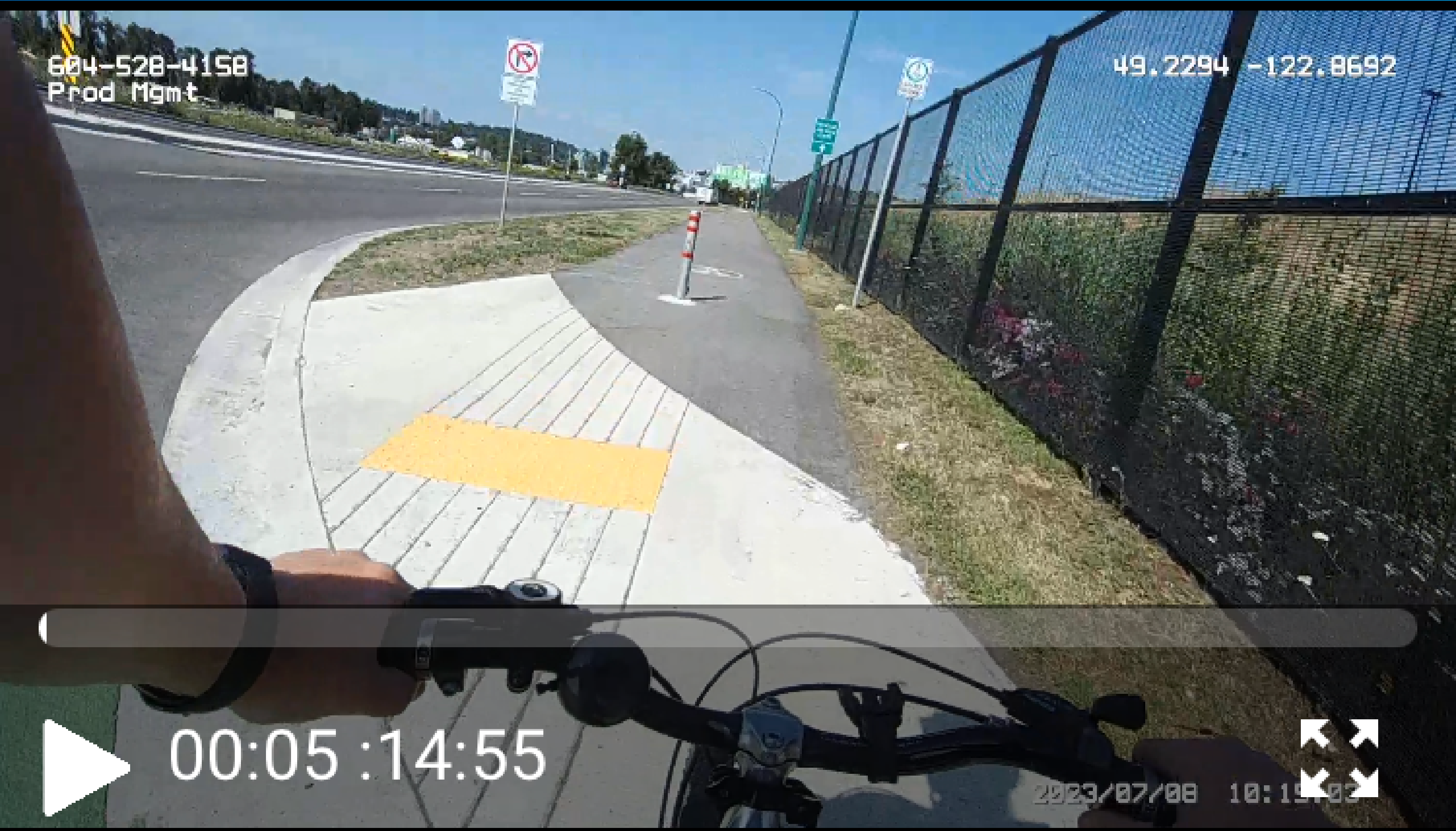
Take the example of **Event/Category**. The values for this property are populated in the back office your organization uses. That is why when you tap inside the box, a list of values appears. Scroll to find the value you are looking for, and select it.

## Edit Properties

For other properties, you must enter the values manually. For example, for the property **Partner ID**, tap in the box, and type the value using your keypad.

# Filter the Video List

Use any of these filters to view a filtered list: **Event/Category**, **Start date**, and **End date**. Now tap **Apply**. You need not use all the filters at the same time. For example, you can use only **Event/Category** to filter the list. **Select Event/Category** shows the list of possible Event/Category types in the back office. Select from the list, and tap **Apply**.

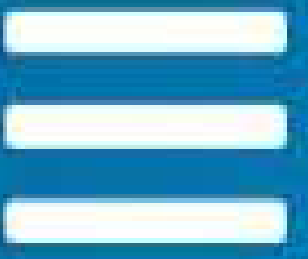

## Enable Video Selection

For non-Nexus users, you can use the **Select** button to enable videos selection for bulk association with a partner officer.

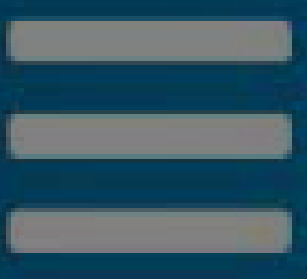
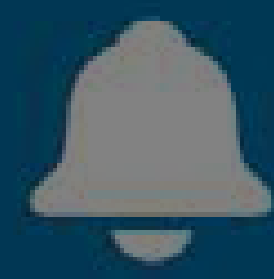

## Select Videos

## Body Camera Settings

Tap the **Body Camera Settings** in the menu to open the **Body Camera Settings** page. You can enable/disable the Covert mode on FOCUS X2 by toggling this switch.

The **Body Camera Settings** drop-down on the main page should reflect the current Covert mode status (as well as Bluetooth and GPS). The latter two cannot be changed via FMA.



## Access Diagnostics

From the menu, tap **Body Camera Diagnosis**.

This initiates a diagnostic test in order to determine if the Body Camera is facing issues. For example, if there is an issue with upgrading the Body Camera's firmware, the diagnostic test will report that.

Once the test completes, the results are displayed here. In this example, no issues were reported. However, if the test reports issues, contact your administrator to see how to fix them. Once done, tap **OK**.

# Access Notifications

The  icon displays the notification count whenever new notifications are available. You can access notifications either by tapping this icon or by tapping **Notifications** from the menu options that appear after you tap  in the top-right corner. This opens a list of notifications, if any.

## View Notifications

Notifications, if any, appear here.

Examples of notification entries are “low battery” and “full memory”.

You can tap the Sort icon next to the column name to sort the columns.

If you tap on the notifications, there may be more detail available in a popup. In the case of the above notifications, it shows the G-force of the impact.

## Other Menu Options

If you tap **Dashboard**, the FMA home screen will appear. Tapping **Help** opens the in-app help, which you are reading right now.

## Exit FMA

Tap **Accept** to close FMA. Please note that disconnecting from the FOCUS X2 will cause it to deactivate the X2 WiFi. If you log out, the FOCUS X2 will no longer display **FMA WiFi** and will briefly show **AP Off**.

If you want to reconnect from FMA, you may need to re-enable the WiFi AP on FOCUS X2 first.
